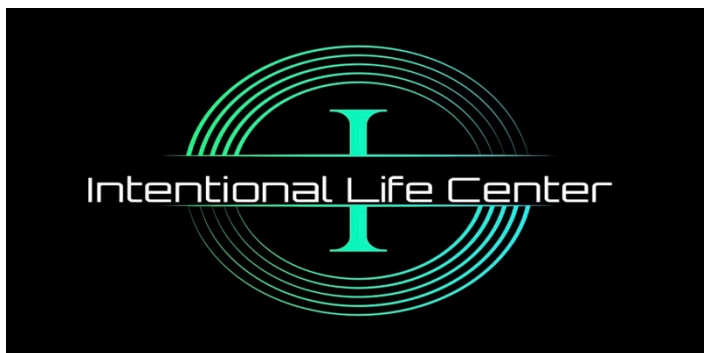

**To Leverage the Unseen Power of Influence
with Others, I Must ...**

1. See Potential.

“Mighty hero, the Lord is with you!” ‘But Lord,’ Gideon replied, ‘My clan is the weakest in the whole tribe of Manasseh, and I am the least in my entire family!’ The Lord said to him, ‘I will be with you.’” Judges 6:12,15-16 (NLT)

2. Speak Possibilities.

“When Israel saw the sons of Joseph, he asked, ‘Who are these?’” Genesis 48:8 (NIV)



“They are the sons God has given me here,” Joseph said to his father. Then Israel said, ‘Bring them to me so I may bless them.’” Genesis 48:9 (NIV)

“Israel reached out his right hand and put it on Ephraim’s head, though he was the younger, and crossing his arms, he put his left hand on Manasseh’s head, even though Manasseh was the firstborn. He blessed them that day... ‘Israel will pronounce this blessing, ‘May God make you like Ephraim and Manasseh!’ So, he put Ephraim ahead of Manasseh.” Genesis 48:14,20 (NIV)

3. Support Becoming.
